This qualification is designed for those involved in the practical application and/or management of health and safety and is appropriate to learners from a variety of sectors including Energy, Oil & Gas, Retail, Corporate Business, and Construction.

They will have an autonomous role in their organisation for managing health and safety policy and practice. They will report direct to or be part of the senior management team. They will recommend and implement changes relevant to their role. They will be aware of cost implications and budgetary control.



Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification, however CADUK will not enroll any learner onto this program unless we are certain that they are able to achieve it.

IOSH Graduate Membership

Candidates that complete Unit 611 – Professional development and ethics in health and safety management will achieve IOSH Graduate membership. Once candidates have achieved the Graduate membership, they can gain Chartered membership by taking an open-book assessment and interview.

CSCS Black Card

For Health & Safety Managers in the Construction Industry, this qualification also provides access to the Black CSCS Card.

Assessment Method

The qualification is assessed by practicing safety professionals holding CMIOSH status, with experience in numerous industries, including energy, oil & gas, retail and corporate business.

Our Health and Safety NVQs are primarily delivered interactively using a variety of methods such as skype, telephone, email, remote desktop and our unique, simple to use online ePortfolio system.

Direct observation of practice by a qualified assessor must also be carried out for a minimum of one mandatory unit.

Qualification Duration
